

The Rite of Sending

Last year we celebrated the Rite of Welcome for Grea Nelson as he made public his intention to be baptized in the Catholic Church. Today we celebrate the Rite of Sending in which we send him to St. Mary's Cathedral in St. Cloud to meet Bishop Kettler. Over this past year Grea Nelson has faithfully attended his Becoming Catholic sessions and participated in Sunday worship. His sponsor, Jim Mergan, and I have seen real growth in his faith and practice and believe he is ready to be baptized at the Easter Viail. When an adult is baptized they also celebrate Confirmation and share in their First Communion at the same time. Since the Bishop is the normal person who confirms, and the Bishop can't be present in all the parishes at the Easter Vigil, all those who will be baptized are sent to meet the Bishop on the First Sunday of Lent.

The Rite of Election

The ceremony with the Bishop is called the Rite of Election because we celebrate that God has chosen Grea Nelson to be baptized. To symbolize his Election by God, Grea Nelson will sign his name to the Book of the Elect. In the Book of Revelation it states that the one on the throne will read the names of all those who are saved from the Book of the Elect. Please join me in praying for and supporting Greg Nelson as he makes his final preparation to become a Catholic Christian.

Today's Gospel

February 17, 2018 The First Sunday of Lent



The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. -Mark 1:12-13

In Mark's Gospel, the desert marks beginning of Jesus' battle with Satan; the ultimate test will be in Jesus' final hours on the cross. In a similar way, our Lenten observances are only a beginning, a preparation for and a reinforcement of our ongoing struggle to resist the temptations we face in our lives. During Lent, we are led by the Holy Spirit to remember the vows of Baptism in which we promised to reject sin and to follow Jesus. Just as Jesus was ministered to by the angels, God also supports us in our struggle against sin and temptation.
