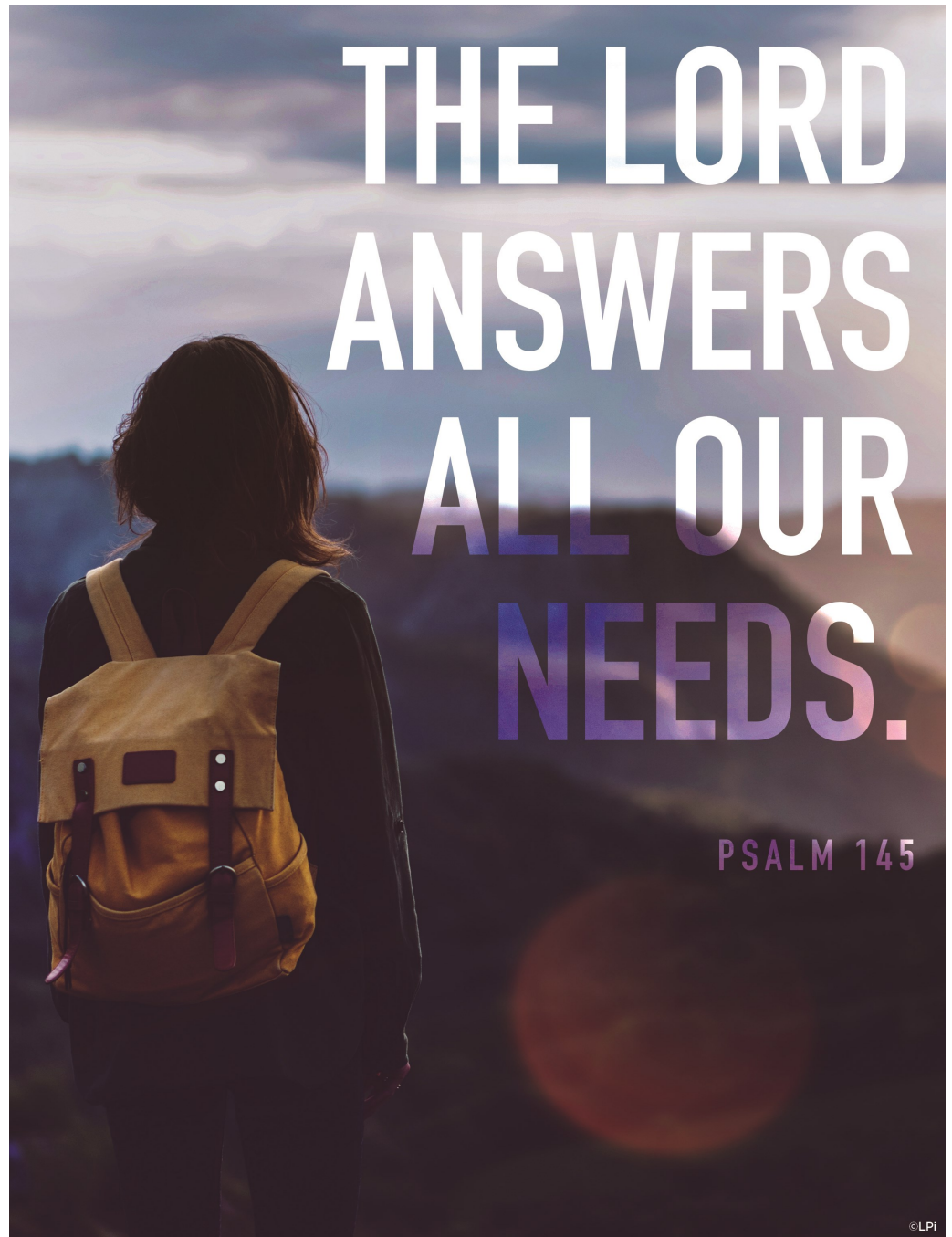

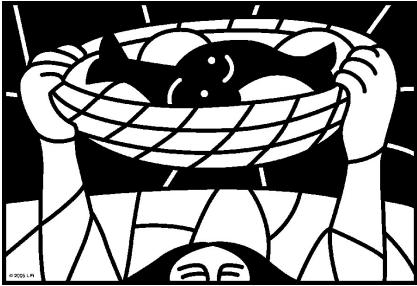

GOSPEL REFLECTION—AUGUST 2



“His heart was moved with pity for them and he cured their sick.”

These words from the Gospel for today remind us that Jesus cares for his people. The Gospel goes on to tell the story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. Jesus has pity on the crowd and chooses not to send them away hungry. The faith of the apostles is challenged as he tells them to provide food for the people, and they have so little there. He asks for the food they have – five loaves and two fish. He blesses the food and then directs the apostles to feed the people. All ate and were satisfied.

As we attend Mass each week, or watch it on line, we are fed with the Eucharist either in reality or spiritually. This is our source of strength for the days ahead. Take time this week to thank God for the gift of the Eucharist which God freely gives to us.

This Gospel also calls us to feed the hungry. We can do this by giving to the food shelf or by sharing with a neighbor. We can also provide nurturing for others through our prayers.

GOSPEL REFLECTION—AUGUST 9



“Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.”

These words from the Gospel called the apostles up short when they were fearful of the storm. Then Peter, who always speaks first says, if it is you, let me walk on the water. Jesus does this and then Peter gets scared and loses trust. Jesus then challenges Peter with the words, “O you of little faith, why did you doubt?”

What is the message for us today? How often do we give up when we pray, and we don't get the answer we want? Do we really listen for God's response to our prayer? Sometimes he gives us something better than we asked for! Often God knows better what we need. This is the challenge for us to trust even when life gets stormy. Is our faith strong enough to believe that God will take care of us?
