GOSPEL REFLECTION—NOVEMBER 19



Today's Gospel is the story of a man going on a journey. He entrusts his possessions to his servants, giving one five talents, one two talents and the other one talent. He did this based on their ability. He expected them to

increase the gift they received. When he returned the one with the five and the one with the two talents had doubled theirs. The one who received the one talent was afraid of failing so he buried it and then returned it to the master. The master commends those who had increased their gifts by giving them greater responsibility. The one who buried the treasure had his talent given to the one who had five. What is the message for us? To each person God gives abilities and gifts that we are to use in the service of others. These are often referred to as time, talent and treasure. How do we use these gifts in service in our family and in our Church? Take time this week to reflect on the talents you have been given and how you are using them.




