### WHAT MATTERS AT CHRISTMAS

As the Holiday Season approaches memories of special events and occurrences tend to be very easy to recall.

Someone recently spoke about being in a different country for Thanksgiving or for the first time being scheduled to work on Christmas and miss a traditional family celebration. The conversations prompted me to start thinking about what really is important during the Holiday Season and for that matter every season.

A recent impressive communication was with a family who each Christmas Season identify a person or family who is having hardships. The hardships sometimes are financial and sometimes emotional such as being home bound or without family support. Their goal is to add joy and letting the person or family know they are important and cared about. Part of the caring event is to provide a small, decorated Christmas tree and find time to visit and pray with the person or persons. Their main goal is to let them know that they are valued and cared about.

Another impressive communication was with a special friend who shared how she was asked to pray with a terminally ill acquaintance. The friend shared her apprehension but more importantly the lasting memory of praying together.

These role models helped me to remember being an 18-year-old student nurse, away from home on Christmas for the first time. A terminally ill patient asked me to help him pray for maybe the last time. What a privilege and blessing for me. A memory I recall each Christmas.

### GOSPEL REFLECTION—DECEMBER 3

### WATCH-BE ALERT!

This week we begin the Season of Advent, the beginning of the New Church Year. As you look back over the last year, how have you done in deepening your relationship with God? What are some things you would like to do this year?

Advent is a time of preparation for the coming of Christ – both at the Feast of Christmas and at the final coming. It is an opportunity for each of us to reflect on our own lives – spiritual and material – to determine how we will make this preparation. We can get caught in the hustle and bustle of Christmas preparation and lose track of our need for spiritual preparation.

The Gospel for this Sunday reminds us to "watch" and "be alert". The last few weeks we have heard similar reminders. Today, Jesus tells the story of a man leaving his servants in charge of his possessions as he goes on a journey. Since they do not know when he will return, they need to be prepared at all times. So, it is with us. We, too, must be prepared because we do not know when Christ will come for us. During this week, make a specific plan as to the preparations you will make. How will you deepen your relationship with God? Additional time for prayer and the plan to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation can be a way to start.


