- Christmas Eve, 5:00pm at the Abbey Church: Something to consider: In the past we

 had Ushers, EM, Gifts, Readers, from both parishes do the jobs???
 Julie will talk to David O. and have him make suggestions of people from St. Joe who
 could assist.
- Reconciliation: First Reconciliation on December 14, 1:00PM: Program needs to be done and shared with Fr. Brad and Julie Tess will revise the service from last year. Susan will be contacted to play music for the service.
- 5. Protocol for Gluten Free Hosts: Concern about plastic wrapper being blessed and holy Possible remedy: Sacristan places Pyx with GF host in dish with other hosts, Fr. consecrates, Distribution as normal–person with GF goes to Fr., Return PYX to Fr. or sacristan after mass for clean up This was handled....no need for a change.
- January 5, Epiphany: Social Justice will kick off the Emergency Catholic Charities Event in February with both parishes as an ACC project.
 This was changed to January 12. January 5th will be the opening ceremony of the Sesquicentennial events.
- Parking Lot: Still people who are attending mass in vehicles—averages 10-12 per Sunday
 Continue offering masses to people. It is a good service to provide for people.
- 8. <u>Sesquicentennial Events</u>: Faith Formation will have a Saint project for classes to work on. Each week a write up by a FF student will be placed in the bulletin in a corner called, "Sesquicentennial Saints." Tess will create a format for information about the saint for the child to share. Then in October, we will do a walk to the cemetery with a scavenger hunt about the saints. When we get to the cemetery, we will discuss the saints and the items they found which represent the saint.

 Tess will develop a sheet for students to fill in. She will write up and submit the saint information for bulletin publication. Saint Scavenger will be October 12, 2025.
- 9. Suggestion was made by a visitor who was staying at the House of Prayer; She was the environment person at Joan of Arc Parish in the Cities. She came to look at our worship spaces. She loved the big hall as the furniture is moveable. She said there are so many more options for set up to worship. She also saw Mary Chapel and thought it was amazing. Her comment–Stations of the Cross are too large for the space. Suggestion of using numbers, similar to those in the Abbey Church on the walls for the Stations. Thoughts....

bring part of our old worship space to our present worship space as part of our Sesquicentennial events.
